

# FAMOCO MDM 2.3

MDM 2.3 update is available as of Thursday August 1, 2019 at 8:30pm (Paris/Brussels time). Service unavailability may occur with 30 min to 1 hour approximate duration during roll-out.

## IMPROVEMENTS

### APPLICATIONS FILE MAX SIZE INCREASED TO 300MB

The App Library now accepts APK file upload up to 300MB (instead of 200MB previously).

### TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

This new optional user authentication security enforcement will roll-out progressively (access restricted to selected users) after this release:

- Users can disable the feature without getting locked outside MDM.
- Users connecting from multiple browsers must provide an authentication code as set.

## FIXES

- A limited number of clients experienced a device side-panel crash, it was caused by a faulty APK file parsing when extracting the application icon. In addition to this fix, we advise to reupload recent APK files when the corresponding icon is broken in MDM.
- Profile edition contains a drop-down to add applications to a profile, we fixed it in order to let users smoothly add multiple applications (it was necessary to delete the previous app name from the drop-down before adding the next one).
- While using the “put in organization” action, current organization was suggested to users among destination options. The list is now filtered and doesn’t display any useless option.
- The fleet filter “N/A” option display was not persistent when users were leaving and then coming back to the initial filtered page.

## OPERATIONS

### OLD INTERFACE SHUTDOWN

The old FMS interface, hosted on [my.famoco.com](http://my.famoco.com), is outdated and remains accessible until August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. Devices data is up to date on the new MDM platform at [mdm.famoco.com](http://mdm.famoco.com) alongside with enhanced features.
